PITCH

Two childhood friends take on the adventure of being on an alpine pasture to revive their friendship. But their dream fades as the inhospitable environment and rivalries generated by a shepherdess take their toll. The result is a sometimes funny, but also shocking and utterly honest alpine film.

SYNOPSIS

Take some time off and feel the nature. That was the goal of the two childhood friends Manu and Robin. Armed with a camera, a manual and plenty of enthusiasm, they decide to take on the adventure of being on an alpine pasture, during the summer. To revive their old friendship, find freedom and make a film about their time on the alp. But their dream fades gradually and relentlessly as the inhospitable environment, rivalries generated by the presence of a shepherdess, sick and finally perished livestock take their toll. The result is an alpine film devoid of embellished cows and Swiss crosses, but is instead unsparing, shocking and utterly honest – and at times incredibly funny.



NOTE FROM MANUEL LOBMAIER

Author & Protagonist

A place of freedom

To me, the alpine pasture always was an allegory for a peculiar kind of freedom.

To revive the friendship with my childhood friend we turned a long desired idea into action. Make an alp together - what a beautiful place to be happy! To be in the nature, make music together and herd cows. With this idea the nightmare began.

The memories of this summer on the Wildfluhalpt are colorful and confused. How we stage ourselves, funny in the beginning, and then it all turned more and more serious. How we fought in front of the camera in the end, how we carried out our need to be right via camera. Staged scenes blended with documentary ones.

For me, adventures are characterized by the exceedance of an inner or outer limit value. That's uncomfortable and painful. I had to realise that the other ones are probably pseudo-adventures.

We experience how a planned pseudo-adventure became a real one. And how even a fifteen year old friendship can be crushed by the merciless storm of emotions of the cosmos alp.

The first conclusion of our summer on the alp seems dismal: Nature became our opponent, the animals a burden and the best friend an enemy. Never bevore have I made an experience closer to prison.

A different alp movie?

When I was back home at the end of September I had the pile of video tapes with the recordings in my bag. However, I lacked any motivation to concern myself any further with this summer.

Only some time later - after the doubtful pleasure of an alp movie, where neither the bearded happy shepherd nor the decorated cow was missing - I took the decision: I would make the roughly planned and never realised movie out of my recordings of our summer on the alp.

My wish was to depict my subjective memory of the summer as authentic as possible, sometimes based on the notes in my alp diary that I wrote back then - well knowing that my memories will never be completely objective and the movie, if told by Robin, possibly would have looked completely different.


